BIOGRAPHY -

Through my Unseen Press, my limited-edition photographic artists' books have been widely collected by institutions including the MoMA Library, NYC; the Getty Research Institute, LA; and the Kunst Bibliothek, Berlin. I have presented work at two CODEX International Artists' Book Festivals and over the years, some of my teachers in the book arts have included Jeffrey Wolin, Jim Canary, Amos Kennedy, Nathan Lyons, John & Joy Tonkin, and Timothy Ely. Unseen Press is independently run out of Seattle, Washington.

As a photographic book artist, I explore the potential that sequencing images has for generating meanings that extend beyond the single image. Equally important, I am responsible for all designs, digital printing, and fine bindings in my limited edition artists' books. My background is in film, literature, photography, the book arts, and digital media. I lived in Berlin four years directly following the fall of the Berlin Wall in the 1990's, during which time I was the recipient of a Fulbright Scholarship apprenticing to a bookbinder at the Technische Universität (1996-97).

Through my artistic pursuits I am also involved with digital extensions of the book, including interactive video installations, net.art, and multimedia performances. This work has been included in Rhizome.org's ArtBase and has been exhibited at SFcamerawork; the Istanbul Contemporary Art Museum; the Walker Art Center; Springgun Press; and E-Poetery 2013 at Kingston College, UK, among other international venues. My article, What is a Digital Artists' Book, Anyway?, was published in the Journal of Artists' Books v.33., 2013 and in 2016 I contributed three critical essays to the CBAA Book Arts Theory Blog, *The Haptic in Artists' Books*, Co-Create/Curate, and The Zine as a Means.

A focus in all of my productions is to create works that integrate emotion and intellect through the investigation of themes such as consciousness, perception, and memory, as well as history and the relations between people, social/environmental issues, and technology.
